## **PASCHA NOTE**

If you're using Holy Saturday morning as your Paschal Service, Baskets will be blessed following the service in the Hall. Everyone is invited to the Midnight Pascha

Service, although some will be in the Hall where the service will be streamed. Those who are faithful with their attendance at the Services of Holy Week, will be offered seating in the Church first. After that, remaining names will be entered into a Randomizing Program to determine location in either the Hall or Church. This seemed to be the only fair solution. Everyone may participate in the Procession. Baskets will be blessed in the Pavilion after the Liturgy but should remain in your car during the Service. Afterwards, anyone wishing to remain at church to partake of their baskets can use the hall with the seating as is. Following the Paschal Vespers on Sunday at Noon, an Egg Hunt will take place for the kids.
