### Schools Reopen for Classes

After a seven-month shutdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Uganda's schools began to reopen in mid-October. Tertiary institutions are holding face-to-face lectures for students in their final year, adhering to standard safety procedures established by the Uganda Ministry of Education. All other tertiary students are to do their classes online. Most of our university and vocational students do not have electricity in their homes and none of them have Wi-Fi, so we set up an internet-enabled room near our office to allow them to participate in the online lectures.

Primary and secondary schools reopened for candidate classes only—Primary 7, Senior 4, and Senior 6. Students in these classes are preparing for national exams which normally take place at this time of year but have been moved to first quarter 2021.

### Students of the Month

Twin brothers **Edward** and **James** are thirteen years old and are in Primary 6 (6th grade). Their mother abandoned them to a great aunt when they were seven. They never knew their father.

For the past four years they've been cared for by their mother's younger sister, one of our graduates. In spite of missing two years of schooling until their aunt stepped in, both boys have been on our honor roll every term since they joined our programme, usually ranking in the top three of their class. One of Jimmy's legs is shorter than the other, caused by a botched injection when he was small. This doesn't prevent him from starring on the school soccer team alongside his brother. Both boys have been elected as student prefects with Jimmy currently holding the position of Head Boy.
