Based on their scores, students who pass are ranked in four divisions. Last year, ten of our students took the exams. All of them finished in the first or second division and have recently completed the first grading period of high school. **Bertram** is twenty years old and was one of the first students to join the St. Nicholas family. His grandmother brought him to us in 2005 when he was seven. At the time, she was caring for a dozen orphaned grandchildren and her mentally ill daughter, Bertram's mother. We enrolled him in first grade and were impressed with his academic achievement each year.

Bertram's dream was to become an engineer, so when he proceeded to Advanced Level high school, he chose Physics, Math, and Economics as his primary subjects, along with computer studies. He was our top-performing student on the national exams, and will begin his studies at Ndejje University in August, majoring in Electrical Engineering.
